## Restoration/Historical Committee

The next Houston Heights Association Restoration/Historical Committee meeting will be held at 226 W 19th St. on Thursday, June 10, from 7:30 to 9:30 PM.

Moving to the Heights with a newborn and starting from scratch, this young couple bought the land in June of 2008 and designed and built their home and studio on a 138x32 parking lot on W 19th St.

The couple designed the home with a Google design program, then were assisted by a friend using a Computer Assisted Design (CAD) program to get the details needed for permits and by engineers to design some plans so they would pass codes. The studio was designed with the help of a professional recording studio designer. A family company in the Woodlands did the construction, and other family members were the general contractors.

The couple decorated for simplicity, without intricate baseboards, moldings, or elaborate woodwork or trim. They used their eclectic furniture and art to warm the feeling of the home; an open great room with 26-foot ceilings and exposed insulation gives it a loft feel.
